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It's cool that the Scrum Master and Product Owner **assign** the tasks to the team members and ask for status every 10 minutes, but we are struggling with our burndown chart



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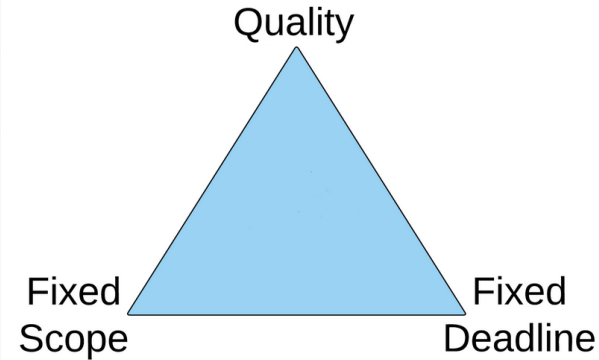
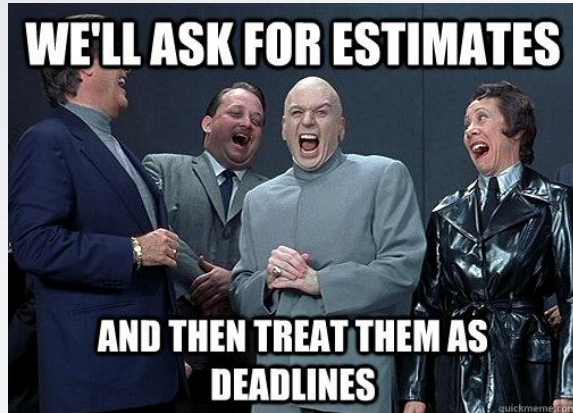
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Meaning: We don't understand the basics and we are focusing on unimportant things

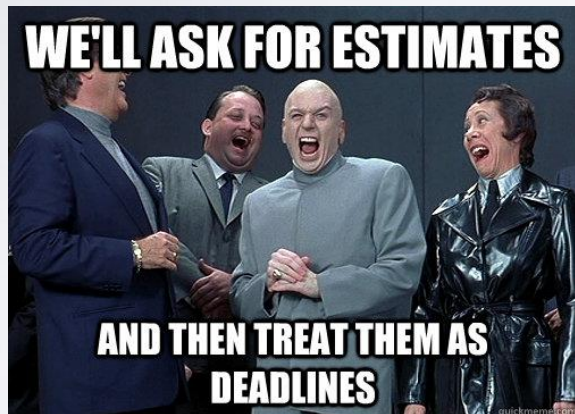
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Our project manager gives us **scope** and a **deadline** (no bugs accepted)

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It produces bad quality code with no “proper” architecture



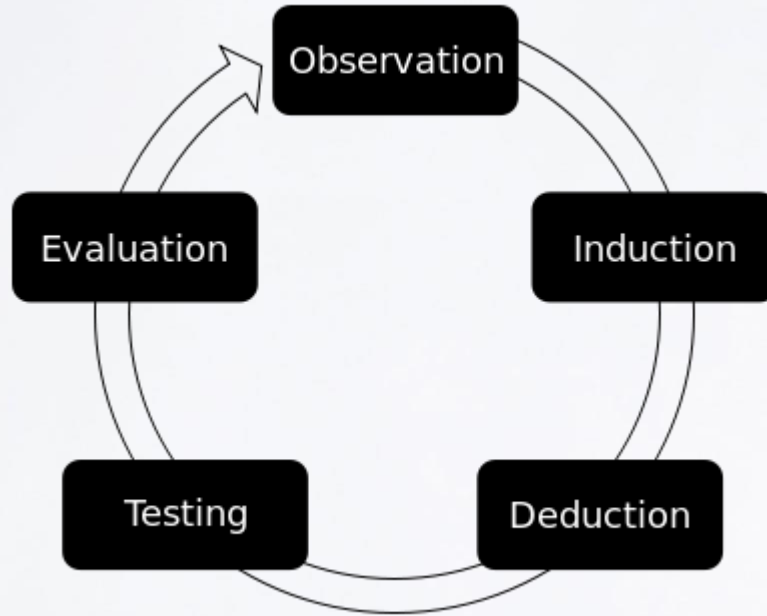
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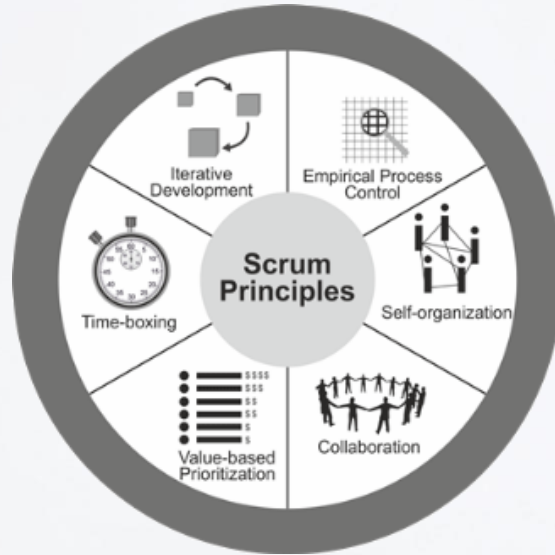
Meaning: Proper **Definition of Done**, architectural **vision**, architectural **skills**, cross-team **communication**?

First learn and understand Scrum and the thoughts behind it...it helps if you have the right people for that...



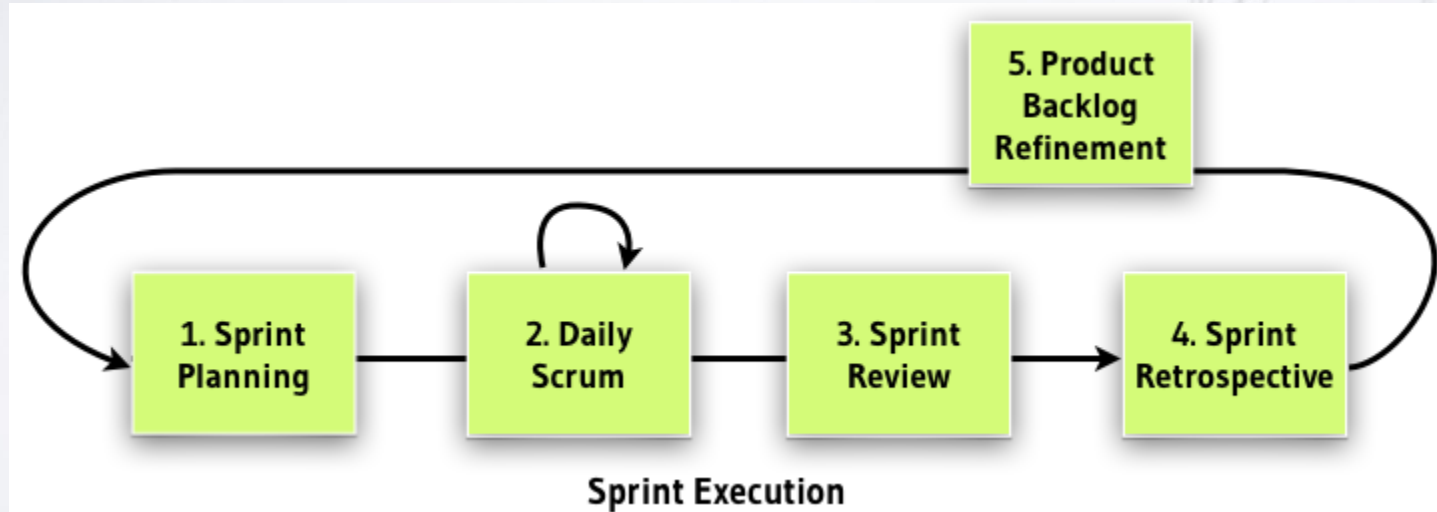
And what do we recommend
